## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act authorizing the town of Barnstable to lease land for use as a for-profit museum.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 265 of the acts of two thousand and
- 2 six and any other general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Barnstable is hereby
- 3 authorized to lease a certain parcel of land in the Town of Barnstable, known as the Hyannis
- 4 Armory, located at 225 South Street, Hyannis, MA, together with buildings and structures
- 5 thereon, for use as a for-profit museum.
