An Act authorizing the town administrator of Southborough to sign warrants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The town administrator shall, on behalf of and subject to policies  
2 established by the board of selectmen of the town of Southborough, have the authority to sign all  
3 warrants or vouchers, including payroll warrants, for the payment of town funds submitted by the  
4 town accountant in accordance with section 56 of chapter 41 of the General Laws.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
