An Act establishing the maximum age for school attendance in the city of Lawrence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION I.
- 2           Notwithstanding section 1B of Chapter 69 and section 1 of Chapter 76 of the
- 3           General Laws or any other general or special law, rule, regulation to the contrary, the
- 4           school committee of the City of Lawrence may establish its own maximum age for
- 5           school attendance, which shall be 18 years of age, or upon the completion of a high
- 6           school diploma, providing that the age is not younger than the mandatory maximum
- 7           age for school attendance established by the board of education.
- 8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
