# The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act designating the official seasoning of the commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section (x). "Bell's Seasoning," created by William G. Bell, a Boston inventor in 1867

3 and manufactured in East Weymouth Massachusetts, shall be the official seasoning of the
