An Act authorizing the late filing of a tax abatement application for the Amherst Committee for a Better Chance, Inc.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the board of
2 assessors of the Town of Amherst shall accept an application for abatement of property tax on
3 behalf of the Amherst Committee for a Better Chance, Inc. for the tax year 2013. This
4 application shall be considered timely if filed with the assessors within ninety days after the
5 effective date of this act.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
