## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act relative to postpartum depression screening.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby 2 amended by inserting after Section 10G the following: -

Section 10H. The division shall provide coverage of screenings by pediatricians for postpartum depression in mothers of newly born children during any visit to a pediatrician's office taking place for up to one year from the date of the child's birth.
