An Act authorizing the change of use of certain conservation land in the town of Duxbury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           A certain parcel of land located in the town of Duxbury, designated as “LOT 2 2.91  
2 ACRES (HHA PARCEL)” on that certain “Plan of Land, TEMPLE STREET, KEENE STREET  
3 and NORTH STREET in DUXBURY, MA” by Aaberg Associates Inc., dated September 16,  
4 2008 and recorded in the Plymouth registry of deeds in Plan Book 54, Page 987, and being a  
5 portion of the town land described in a deed recorded with the Plymouth registry of deeds in  
6 book 36608, page 240, may be used for community housing purposes.
