An Act allowing for the appointment of designees to the Inspector General Council.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 12A, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

3           There shall be an inspector general council, which shall consist of the attorney general or  
4 her designee, the state auditor or her designee, the secretary of public safety or her designee, the  
5 state comptroller or his designee, an attorney admitted to practice law within the commonwealth  
6 appointed by the attorney general from a list of three such attorneys submitted by the speaker of  
7 the house, a person with experience in business or accounting or on the faculty of a college of  
8 business or of accounting within the commonwealth appointed by the state auditor from a list of  
9 three such persons submitted by the president of the senate, a member of the public appointed by  
10 the governor from a list of three names submitted by the minority leader of the house of  
11 representatives, and a member of the public appointed by the governor from a list of three names  
12 submitted by the minority leader of the senate.
