An Act relative to licensing in the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 32 of Chapter 147 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 169  
2 of the Acts of 2009, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (d), the following section:-

3           (e) Notwithstanding Section 13A of Chapter 30A, or any other section of the general  
4 Laws to the contrary, the license shall be granted to an applicant, regardless if the applicant is a  
5 citizen of the United States or an alien as defined by 8 USC 1101 (a) (3), as long as said  
6 applicant provides a form of identification sufficient to identify the applicant.
