An Act to preserve 2nd Amendment Rights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “license”, in line 236, the
3 following words:- “and all rights and privileges”.

4 SECTION 2. Paragraph (e) of said section 131 of said chapter 140 of the General Laws,
5 as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
6 paragraph:-

7 On the day an application is submitted for renewal of a license, the licensing authority
8 shall issue a receipt of notification that a renewal application has been submitted and is pending
9 review. The receipt shall include the date the renewal application was submitted and the date of
10 expiration for the application, which shall be 180 days from the submission of the renewal
11 application. The receipt shall also recognize that all rights and privileges shall be preserved while
12 the renewal application is pending review.

13 SECTION 3. Said section 131 of said chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
14 striking out, in lines 236, 241, 269, 318 and 331 , the figure “90” and inserting in place thereof
15 the following figure:- 180.
