An Act relative to transportation of regional vocational schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 68 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 at the end thereof:

3           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, regional vocational schools  
4 may assess a transportation fee to transported students up to an amount sufficient to cover the  
5 costs incurred by the district, provided, however, that a transported student who is eligible for  
6 free or reduced lunch under the federal school lunch program shall not be required to pay the fee.
