An Act relative to unemployment insurance rates.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to lower forthwith the cost of unemployment insurance, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, for  
2 calendar year 2014, the experience rate of an employer qualifying therefor under subsection (b)  
3 of section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws shall be the rate which appears in column "E"  
4 of clause (1) of subsection (i) of said section 14 of said chapter 151A.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 2014.
