An Act relative to racing days.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION AA. Notwithstanding Section 2 of Chapter 128C of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, or any other general or special law to the contrary, in
3 calendar year 2014, no racing meeting licensee located in Norfolk County shall simulcast live
4 races in the racing season unless the racing meeting licensee is licensed to and actually conducts
5 at least 720 live races over the course of not less than 80 calendar days during the 2014 racing
6 season with no fewer than 7 races completed on any of those 80 calendar days.

7 Section BB. Section AA is hereby repealed.

8 Section CC. Section BB shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
