An Act relative to fire safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 81 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "installation", in line 15, the
3 following words:- , service, testing, maintenance and inspection.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 81 of said chapter 146, as so appearing, is hereby further
5 amended by inserting after the word "modification,", in line 22, the following word:- service,.

6 SECTION 3. Said section 81 of said chapter 146, as so appearing, is hereby further
7 amended by inserting after the word "inspection,", in line 23, the following word:- testing.

8 SECTION 4. Said section 81 of said chapter 146, as so appearing, is hereby further
9 amended by striking out, in line 62, the word "who" and inserting in place thereof the following
10 words:- employed by a licensed fire sprinkler contractor who.
