1 *Ordered,* That the committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure be
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of
3 Senate documents numbered 82, 94, 96, 102, 106, 109, 117, 135, 144, 160, and 162 and House
4 documents numbered 177, 182, 183, 194, 201, 230, 234, 243, 260, 286, 294, 299, 300, 3305, and
5 3575, relative to Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure.

6 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
7 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
9 on or before December 31, 2014.
