An Act relative to health insurance benefits for elected officials in the town of Andover.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 32B or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, health insurance benefits for elected officials shall not be  
3 provided by the Town of Andover.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
