An Act relative to parking violations in the town of Wellfleet.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 20A 1/2 of chapter 90 of the  
2 General Laws, the town of Wellfleet is hereby authorized to increase the maximum limit for  
3 parking ticket fines to seventy-five (\$75) dollars if paid within twenty-one (21) days, to eighty  
4 (\$80) dollars, if paid thereafter, but before the parking clerk of said town reports to the registrar  
5 of motor vehicles, and to ninety-five (\$95) dollars if paid thereafter.

6           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
