By Mr. Miceli of Wilmington, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of James R. Miceli and Barry R. Finegold for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Andrea Thomas, an employee of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Andrea Thomas, an employee of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the division of capital asset management and maintenance, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 division of capital asset management and maintenance shall establish a sick leave bank for
3 Andrea Thomas, an employee of the division. Any employee of the division may voluntarily
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Andrea
5 Thomas. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
6 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the division.
7 Whenever Andrea Thomas terminates employment with the division or requests to dissolve the
8 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended
9 illness leave bank.
