An Act authorizing the town of Conway to continue the employment of police officer David Johnson.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, David Johnson,  
2 police officer for the town of Conway, may continue in the position until he reaches 70 years of  
3 age, the date of his retirement or until his non-reappointment, whichever occurs first; provided,  
4 however, that no deductions from the regular compensation of David Johnson shall be made  
5 under chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to his reaching the age of 65 in  
6 connection with his service to the town for retirement or pension purposes.

7           Section 2: This act will take effect upon passage.
