By Mrs. Canavan of Brockton, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Christine E. Canavan for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Mariange Robert, an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Mariange Robert, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of  
2 corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for Mariange Robert of Brockton, an employee of  
3 the department’s headquarters financial office. Any employee of the department may voluntarily  
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Mariange  
5 Robert.

6           Whenever Mariange Robert terminates employment with the department or requests to  
7 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
8 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
9 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
10 the department.
