## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

An Act relative to the elimination of an annual fee by veterans for distinctive license plates.

SECTION 1. The fifteenth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "furnish", in line 390, the following words:- "without charge".

- SECTION 2. Said paragraph of said section 2 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out the third sentence.

- Notwithstanding any provision of this section, no veteran, who is the owner of a private passenger motor vehicle or a motorcycle, shall be charged an annual fee for a distinctive registration plate.
