By Mr. Binienda of Worcester, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of John J. Binienda for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Robert Binton, an employee of the Department of Transportation. Public Service.

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Robert Binton, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish immediately a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Transportation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department
2 of Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Robert Binton, of 10 Tirrell Street,
3 Worcester, Massachusetts 01603, an employee of the Department of Transportation. Any
4 employee of the Department of Transportation may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
5 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Robert Binton. Whenever Robert
6 Binton terminates employment with the Department of Transportation or requests to dissolve the
7 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the Department
8 of Transportation’s paid sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences
9 unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as
10 determined by the Department of Transportation.
