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**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**  
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An Act relative to a real property tax exemption for recipients of social security disability and supplemental security income benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after clause  
2 Forty-first C<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> the following clause:-

3 Forty-first C<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>. Real property occupied as the domicile of a person who owns the same  
4 and receives disability benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act or receives benefits  
5 under the supplemental security income program under Title XVI of such Act.
