An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Michael J. Macuch, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Bay State Correctional Center, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Bay  
2 State Correctional Center shall establish a sick leave bank for Michael J. Macuch, an employee  
3 of the Bay State Correctional Center, to care for his wife Lois Robinson-Macuch. Any employee  
4 of the Bay State Correctional Center may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
5 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Michael J. Macuch. Whenever Michael J.  
6 Macuch terminates employment with the Bay State Correctional Center or requests to dissolve  
7 the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
8 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
9 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
10 the Bay State Correctional Center.
