An Act Relative to Target Share Funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 70 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after
2 section 2, the following section:-

3 SECTION 3: The commonwealth shall appropriate and expend whatever funds
4 necessary to establish a minimum funding contribution of not less than 17.5 per cent of the gross
5 education foundation budget for each municipal, regional or other school district governed under
6 this chapter.
