An Act providing for appointment of the town collector in the town of Shirley.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 1 of chapter 41 of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, there shall be in the town of Shirley a town collector  
3 whom shall be appointed by the board of selectmen for a term not to exceed three years and  
4 whom may be removed by said board for cause. The appointed town collector shall have all the  
5 powers and duties imposed by law upon town collectors.

6           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 1, any elected incumbent in the office of town  
7 collector as of the effective date of this act shall continue to hold such office and perform the  
8 duties thereof until the expiration of the elected term or sooner vacating of office. Upon such  
9 expiration of term or sooner vacating of office, the elected position of town collector shall be  
10 abolished.

11           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
