House of Representatives, September 25, 2014.

1 *Ordered,* That the committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure be
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of
3 Senate documents numbered 80, 93, and 103 and House documents numbered 258, 267 and
4 3466, relative to consumer protection and professional licensure issues.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
8 on or before December 31, 2014.
