An Act authorizing the town of Provincetown to designate a check-off box on its tax bills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. The town of Provincetown may, subject to the approval of the commissioner  
2 of revenue, designate a place on its municipal tax bills, motor vehicle excise tax bills or mail  
3 with such tax bills a separate form whereby taxpayers of the town may voluntarily check off,  
4 donate or pledge an amount of money, which shall increase the amount already due and which  
5 shall be paid over to the Provincetown Affordable Housing Trust Fund, established pursuant to  
6 chapter 230 of the acts of 2002 for the support of the town's affordable housing efforts.

7           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
