By Representative Silvia of Fall River and Senator Rodrigues, a joint petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Alan Silvia and Michael J. Rodrigues for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Jay Viveiros, an employee of the Office of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation. Public Service.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Jay Viveiros, an employee of the Division of Professional Services.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the division of professional licensure, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or specific law to the contrary, the division of  
2 professional licensure shall establish a sick leave bank for Jay Vivieros, an employee of the  
3 division. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal  
4 or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Jay Viveiros. Whenever Jay Viveiros.  
5 Whenever Jay Viveiros terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the  
6 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave time bank shall be transferred to the  
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
9 the department.
