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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**  
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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Lisa Renaud, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2   MAssachusetts Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Lisa Renaud, an  
3   employee of the department. Said Lisa Renaud shall exhaust all of her sick, vacation, personal,  
4   and compensation time, before using any of the time donated to said sick bank. Any employee of  
5   the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick  
6   leave bank for use by Lisa Renaud. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated  
7   to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined  
8   by the department. Whenever Lisa Renaud terminates employment with the department or  
9   requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
10   transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
