An Act relative to the appointment of special police officers in the town of Millbury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The Police Chief of the Town of Millbury may, if the Police Chief deems  
2 necessary, appoint individuals with a law enforcement background as Special Police Officers for  
3 the purpose of performing police details or any other police duties arising there from or during  
4 the course of police detail work, whether or not related to the detail work.

5           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other  
6 general or special law to the contrary, the maximum age for a special police offer appointed in  
7 the town of Millbury shall be 70 years of age.

8           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
