HOUSE No. 4576

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fifteen

An Act relative to the procurement and award of contracts for certain affordable housing in the city of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Construction and development activity related to the rehabilitation by the
2 city of Boston of facilities servicing the homeless population located at 112 Southhampton Street
3 in the city of Boston, or any part thereof, shall not be subject to any general or special law related
4 to the procurement and award of contracts for the construction, reconstruction, installation,
5 demolition, maintenance, design, furnishing or repair of any building by a public agency.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
