# The Commonmealth of flassachusetts 

## In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act prohibiting certain election practices..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 56 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 41A the following section:

Section 41B. No political party, political committee or person, including but not limited to a candidate for elective office or a supporter thereof, shall register a web site that could be identified as the web site of another person who is an elected official, or a candidate or potential candidate for elective office. Whoever knowingly violated this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than $\$ 1,000$ or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months.
