An Act relative to polling places used for the general election.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 25 the  
2 following section(s):—

3 Section 25A. There shall be no school in the public schools that are designated as polling  
4 places on the general election day in presidential races.
