Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 76 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “his name and” in line 1,
3 the following words:- a photo identification, as issued by the registry of motor vehicles,
