An Act relative to absentee voting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 86 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002
- 2 official edition, is amended by striking out the word “physical” in lines 8,
- 3 14 and 17.
