*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 54 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking the words “more than two hooks” and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following:- more than five hooks
