An Act relative to septic systems in manufactured housing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision in the laws and regulations of the  
2 Commonwealth to the contrary, any Manufactured Housing Community in existence prior to  
3 January 1, 2006, for purposes of calculating design flows under 310 CMR 16.00 et seq. and 3.24  
4 CMR 5.00, each septic system which has been installed shall be considered a separate and  
5 distinct facility.
