Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 167 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended in section 2A by striking out the last two paragraphs.
 - SECTION 2. The second paragraph of section 14 of chapter 167 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 14 of chapter 167 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby 6 amended by striking out the third paragraph.
 - SECTION 4. Paragraph 31 of section 2 of chapter 167F of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by the striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:
 - The commissioner shall file the proposed regulation, amendment or repeal with the clerk of the house of representatives, together with a statement that the pertinent provisions of said chapter thirty A have been complied with and a summary of the regulations in layman's terms.
