Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 167D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the words ", established for
- 3 personal, family or household purposes,".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 41A of chapter 171 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words ", established for 6 personal, family or household purposes,".
