**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

\_\_\_\_\_

An Act that removes the town of Brookline as a member community in Norfolk County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of  
2 Brookline shall, on the first day of July, in the year two thousand and thirteen, cease to be a  
3 member community in Norfolk County.

4           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions in SECTION 1., above, the town of  
5 Brookline shall continue to be in the Norfolk Registry District, court system and penal system.

6           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
