An Act relative to the rights of persons licensed by the Department of Public Safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 146 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is hereby  
2 amended by striking section 66 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

3 Prior to suspending or revoking any license or certification issued under this Chapter, to  
4 provide equal protection under the law, an Adjudatory Proceeding shall first be conducted  
5 according to M.G. Law Chapter 30A Sections 1 and 11. The officials of the agency who will  
6 render the final decision shall be appointed by the Chief, who shall appoint three inspectors of  
7 the division, to act together as a board of appeal.
