By Mr. McMurtry of Dedham, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Paul McMurtry and others for legislation to raise the minimum tobacco sales age to 21. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act further regulating the sale of tobacco products.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section
 307C and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3 Section 307C. The department of public health may, in consultation with the attorney

general and the department of revenue, establish regulations for persons engaged in the sale or
shipment of a tobacco product, as defined in section 6 of chapter 270, to prevent the sale or

6 delivery of a tobacco product to persons under 21 years of age in the commonwealth.

SECTION 2. Chapter 270 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section
6 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

9 Section 6. (a) As used in this section, the term, "tobacco product" shall mean any 10 product containing, made, or derived from tobacco or nicotine that is intended for human 11 consumption, whether smoked, chewed, absorbed, dissolved, inhaled, snorted, sniffed, or 12 ingested by any other means, including, but not limited to: cigarettes, cigars, little cigars, 13 chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff, or electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic pipes, 14 or other similar products that rely on vaporization or aerosolization. "Tobacco product" includes 15 any component, part, or accessory of a tobacco product. "Tobacco product" does not include any 16 product that has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for sale as a 17 tobacco cessation product and is being marketed and sold solely for the approved purpose.

18 (b) Whoever sells a tobacco product to any person under the age of 21 or, not being his

19 or her parent or guardian, gives a tobacco product to any person under the age of 21 shall be

- 20 punished by a fine of not less than \$100 for the first offense, not less than \$200 for a second
- 21 offense and not less than \$300 for any third or subsequent offense.
