An Act relative to “up-skirt” and “down-blouse” electronic surveillance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 105(a) of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place
3 thereof the following new sentence:-

4 “Partially nude”, the exposure of the human genitals, buttocks, pubic area or female
5 breast below a point immediately above the top of the areola, including the exposure of a
6 person’s undergarments without that person’s knowledge and consent.
