An Act relative to the Lance Corporal Andrew J. Zabierek Memorial Bridge In the town of Chelmsford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1       The department of highways shall place four signs, one on the north  
2 bound side of Route 495 and one on the south bound side of Route 495, and one on either side of  
3 the bridge on Route 4, in the town of Chelmsford, at the location of the bridge designated as the  
4 “Lance Corporal Andrew J. Zabierek Memorial Bridge”, named in memory of Lance Corporal  
5 Andrew J. Zabierek who was killed in action in Iraq on May 21, 2001 while in the service of the  
6 United States and who was awarded the Military Order of the Purple Heart posthumously. Said  
7 signs visible on Route 495 in both directions shall be attached to the bridge.

8           Said signs shall include the following, “Lance Corporal Andrew J. Zabierek Memorial  
9 Bridge”, “Purple Heart” and the Purple Heart emblem and seal of the commonwealth.
