An Act relative to other tobacco products.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The executive office of health and human services shall be directed to
- 2 instruct the department of public health to promulgate regulations for restricting the marketing,
- 3 labeling and restricting youth access to so called “Other Tobacco Products”.
