In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to health care provider transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 51 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Any health care facility licensed pursuant to this section shall provide transportation via 4 taxi, car or bus service or other form of private or public transportation for the return commute

taxi, car or bus service or other form of private or public transportation for the return commute
from the institution for all resident physicians, medical students and other health care providers

6 who have worked for more than 16 consecutive hours, and for any health care provider who

7 judges herself or himself to be too fatigued to safely operate a motor vehicle.
