An Act relative to cleanliness in restaurants and bars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office of health  
2   and human services shall promulgate rules and regulations to phase out the use of standing  
3   chemical water for the cleaning of utensils, plates, and beverage containers in every club, hotel,  
4   pub brewery, restaurant, and tavern, as defined in section 1 of chapter 138 of the general laws, in  
5   the Commonwealth. Upon promulgation of said rules and regulations the secretary shall instruct  
6   all parties named herein to discontinue the use of standing chemical water as a cleaning device  
7   for utensils, plates, and beverage containers as of January 1, 2013.
