### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to implementing a blue alert system in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 18¾ of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following clause:-
- 3 (10) to develop and implement a statewide blue alert system to be activated when law 4 enforcement officials are searching for an individual who is wanted in the serious injury or 5 killing of a police officer, state trooper, or other law enforcement official.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, 7 is hereby amended by inserting after section 19A the following section:-
- 8 Section 19B. The executive office of public safety shall coordinate the implementation of a statewide blue alert system, pursuant to section 21 of chapter 22.
- SECTION 3. Chapter 22 of The General Laws are hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 12 Section 21.
- 13 THE STATEWIDE BLUE ALERT SYSTEM

Section 1. The following terms as used in this chapter shall, unless the context clearly appears otherwise, have the following meanings:

"Executive office", the executive office of public safety.

"Law enforcement agency", a law enforcement agency with jurisdiction over the investigation of a crime resulting in the serious injury or death of a police officer, state trooper, or other law enforcement official.
