An Act relative to fire safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting in line 15 after the word “installation” the following: “, service, testing, maintenance  
3 and inspection”.

4           SECTION 2. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
5 inserting in line 22 after the word “modification” the following: “service,”.

6           SECTION 3. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
7 inserting in line 23 after the word “inspection” the following: “testing”.

8           SECTION 4. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended in line  
9 63 by striking the word “who” and inserting the following: “employed by a licensed fire  
10 sprinkler contractor who”.
